In addition, potential applicants must provide:

- 1. Copy of 2020 property tax statement.
- 2. Copy of 2021 income tax statement.
- 3. Copy of the current homeowner's insurance statement.
- 4. Most recent two months of personal bank statements (personal and checking, if applicable).
- 5. Copy of 2021 social security benefits, if applicable.
- 6. If employed, copies of pay stubs for the past three months.
- 7. Proof of any other income (pension, investment, child support, etc.)
